

## Graduation 2017 - Stoll Beading



NWC is committed to creating a welcoming and inclusive environment for everyone in our community. In respect of the Aboriginal tradition of beading, we are offering students the opportunity to purchase their stoll ahead of graduation so they can personally bead it and wear it as they cross the stage.

Here is an example of beaded stolls taken from Aurora College in 2015.

**We ask that NWC students use provided stolls only.**

### **Step-By-Step**

Please find below the step-by-step process to purchase your stoll, bead it and have it for the big day.

1. Call, or go to, the campus front desk and purchase your stoll for \$15.00 +tax  
Adult 12 – GREEN      Institute Credit - WHITE
2. Bead your stoll on your personal time outside of class time. Beads and materials will not be provided by NWC.
3. Bring your stoll back to your Program Coordinator for approval. The Program Coordinator has the right to refuse any stoll that is deemed inappropriate. Once approved, the program coordinator will put your name on your stoll. Your stoll will be tagged and waiting for you at graduation. All stolls must be received by **Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup> at 4:30 p.m. to** be included in graduation.

**Note:** Only Adult 12 and Institute Credit students who are eligible to graduate should purchase a stoll. By purchasing a stoll you are not guaranteeing your ability to graduate this spring. Only the Program Coordinators can determine a student's eligibility to graduate.

### **How to wear your stoll**

To ensure you bead the right side, make sure that you have the long 'v' in the back and the short 'v' in the front. Please see the picture to the right or ask your program coordinator if you require further direction.
